

Notice to Community Members of Birch Creek

Working in partnership with the Denduu Gwich'in Village Council, Interior Regional Housing Authority will be taking applications for the Home Ownership Program in Birch Creek beginning August 20, 2019. The homeowner will be responsible for all utilities and maintenance of the home once selected.

To be eligible, you must show legal documentation of the following:

- Copy of Photo I.D. for every person over the age of 18
- Copy of C.I.B. or Tribal Enrollment Card for all household members
- Criminal background check for everyone 18 or older
- 1040 tax returns for the last 3 years: 2016, 2017, & 2018
- Copies of all Income received; Last two paystubs, all other income
- More details are provided on the application cover sheet

IRHA's Eligibility, Admissions, and Occupancy Policy requires IRHA to use a point system to determine the priority of applicants. This method of selecting applicants is intended to assure that nepotism, politics, and favoritism are avoided during the selection process.
