These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the *Organized Village of Grayling*.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about September 8, 2021 the *Organized Village of Grayling* HUD Alaska Office of Native American Programs for the release of Indian Housing Block Grant Funds under Title I of the Native American Housing and Self Determination Act of 1996, Indian Community Development Block Grant Imminent Threat Application grant program funds under Title I of the Indian Community Development Block Grant Imminent Threat provided under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), (Public Law 116-136): ICDBG-CARES Grants as amended, to undertake a project known as Circle COVID-19 Housing Project for the purpose of new construction projects located at:

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The *Organized Village of Grayling* has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the *Organized Village of Grayling*. All comments received by *September 8, 2021* will be considered by the *Organized Village of Grayling* prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The Organized Village of Grayling certifies to *Alaska ONAP* that Ivan Demientieff in *his* capacity as *First Chief of Organized Village of Grayling* consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. *Alaska ONAP* approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the IHBG and ICDBG CARES to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

Alaska ONAP will accept objections to its release of fund and the *Organized Village of Grayling* certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases:

- (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of *Organized Village of Grayling*;
- (b) the *Organized Village of Grayling* has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58;
- (c) the Organized Village of Grayling or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD *Alaska ONAP*; or
- (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to *HUD Alaska ONAP 3000 C Street, Suite 401, Anchorage, AK 99503-3914* or greg.m.stuckey@hud.gov. Potential objectors should contact *Alaska ONAP* to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
